VOLUNTEER POSITION	JOB DESCRIPTION	YOU ARE:
Set-up 6:00-8:00 am	Assist staff with setting up event. Run through check-list to ensure all set-up tasks are complete. This is a physical position that involves heavy lifting and ability to work quickly.	Strong, able to follow directions, flexible, efficient and a morning person.
Sponsor Support 6:00-8:00 am	Direct sponsors, vendors and entertainment to their designated booths. Helping them get set-up and carrying stuff from their cars if necessary.	Outgoing, cheerful, self-sufficient.
Walker Registration 7:00-11:00 am	Register and check-in participants. Strong attention to detail and people skills needed. Must be punctual to allow time for training before walkers arrive. Two people will be needed to stay longer – until about 1p.m.	Cheerful, friendly, able to work under pressure and detail oriented.
Floater 7:00-11:00 am 10:00 a.m.-1:00 pm	You name it, it will probably need to be done. Flexibility and patience are a must. Bring a book to keep you occupied during down times.	Flexible, patient, cheerful and willing to pitch in however and wherever needed.
Festival Patrol 8:00 - 11:00 am 10:30 am-1:00 pm	As festival patrol you will travel the event and clean up as you go. This includes picking up dog messes, handing out poop bags and keeping dog water bowls filled. Additional, you'll need to empty trash cans and recycle bins as needed.	Friendly, not afraid to get your hands dirty, and flexible.
Registration Line Greeter and Dog Handler 8:00-11:00 am	Position yourself near the lines forming at check-in. Welcome walkers, answer check-in questions, direct people to open lines, and hold dogs while people fill out registration paperwork. *Must have attended the Companion Animal Shelter Dog Skills class*	Cheerful, friendly, efficient, and attended the CAS dog skills class.
Dog Check 8:00-11:00 am 11:00 am - 1:00 pm	Hold onto walkers' dogs while they use the bathroom. Great job for dog lovers! *Must have attended the Companion Animal Shelter Dog Skills class*	Cheerful, friendly, and attended the CAS dog skills class.
Route and Water Station Monitors 9:00 am -Noon	You are the cheerleaders along the route. Additionally, point people in the correct direction on the PAWSwalk route, fill human water cups and dog bowls, keep stations neat, trash contained and help people and dogs get water. Also cheer, encourage and thank walkers as they pass by! Will help set up water stations before the walk starts. Great position for groups!	Cheerful, friendly, and outgoing.
Woo-Hoo Crew 9:15 am - Noon	Welcome walkers at the start and finish line as they return from the walk route with cheering, clapping and smiles. Please do not bring props from home.	Cheerful, friendly, and outgoing.
Clean-up Crew 12:30-3:00pm	Once the event is over, break down everything, load trucks, clean up garbage, empty garbage and recycle bins and take down signage, etc.	Willing to get your hands dirty, efficient, flexible and strong.
