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Math

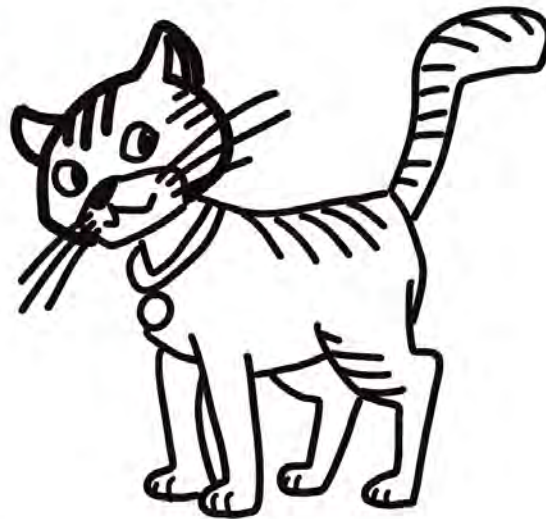
Count how many animals you see outside your home for ten minutes in one place. Repeat four more times in one week to see if there are any patterns in animals.

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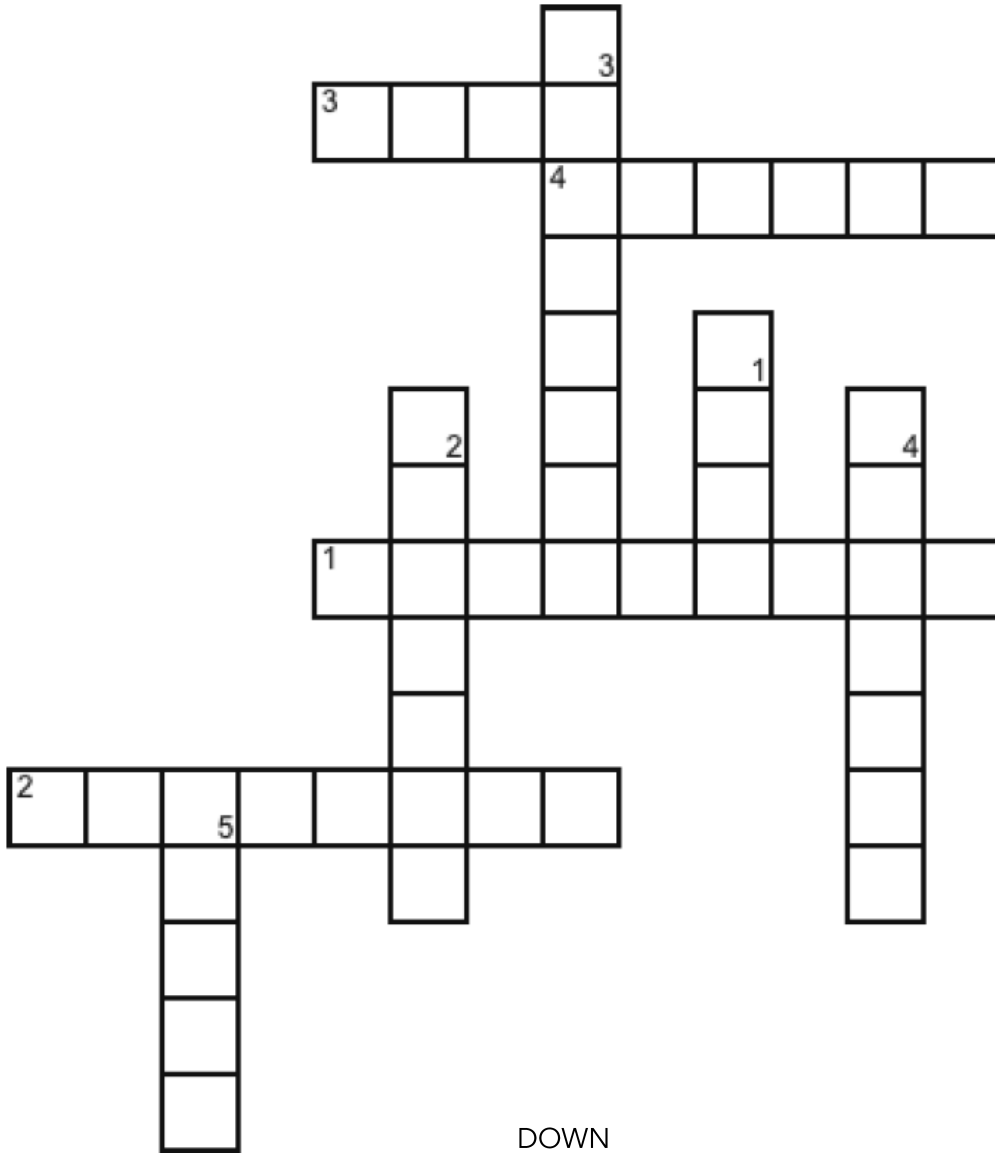
