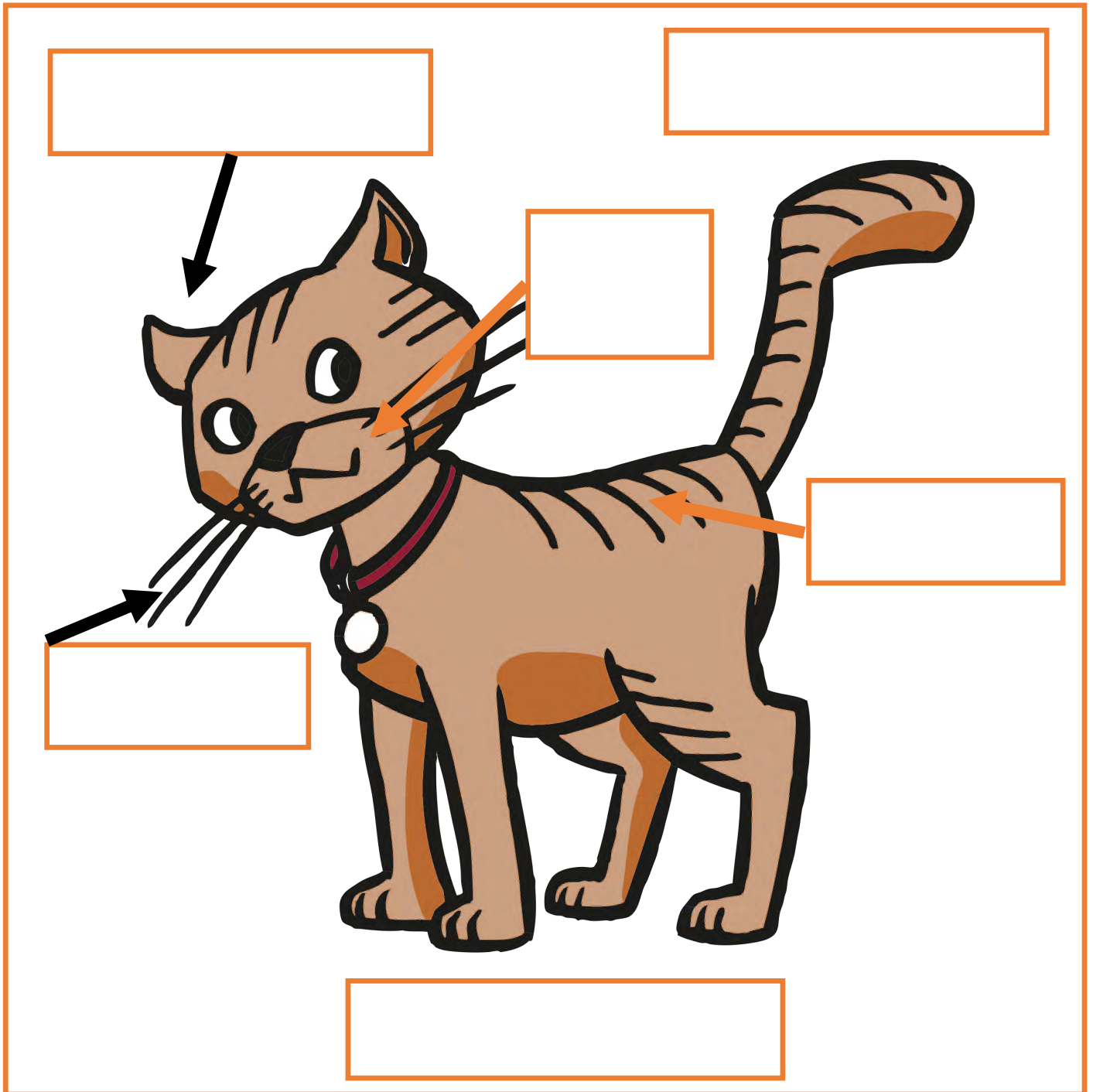
Math
