If the indoor cat lives 19 years and the outdoor cat lives 3 years, how many fewer years does the outdoor cat live?

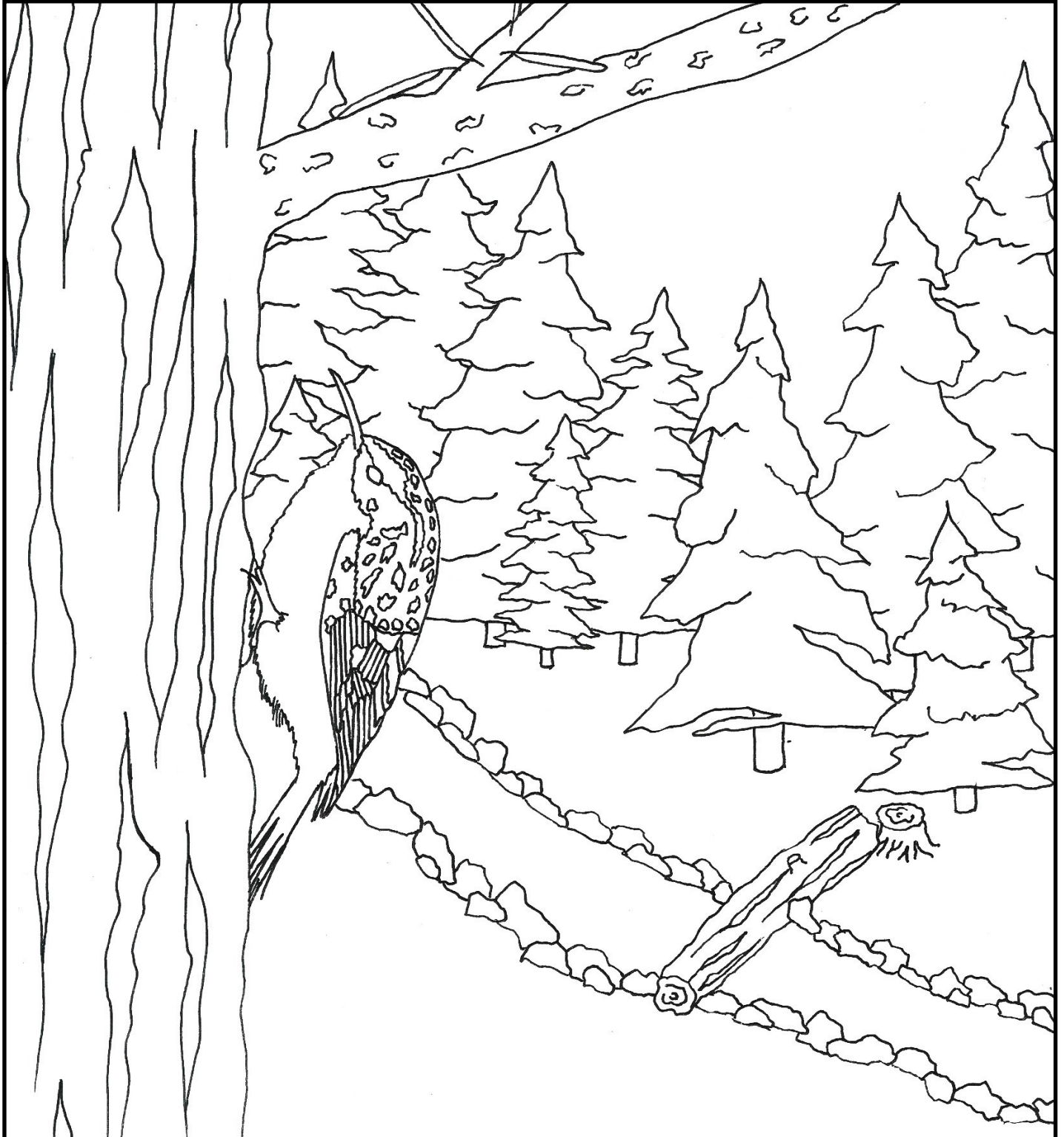
